The Syndicate at its meeting held on 23.10.2020, considered along with the recommendation of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Academic Matters, the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor.

- i. To start the M.Sc Forensic Science programme during the Academic Year 2020-21 and to entrust the conduct of the course with Centre for Integrated Studies.
- ii. To approve the Eligibility Criteria, Intake, Duration of the programme and Fee Structure of M.Sc Forensic Science as follows:

a) Eligibility Criteria :-

B.Sc Degree in Forensic Science/B.Voc Forensic Science/B.Voc Applied Microbiology & Forensic Science/B.Sc Zoology/B.Sc Botany/B.Sc Chemistry/B.Sc Physics/B.Sc Microbiology/B.Sc Medical Microbiology/B.Sc Biochemistry/B.Sc Medical Biotechnology/B.Sc Biotechnology/B.Sc Genetics/B.Tech Computer Science/B.Tech Information Technology/BCA/B.Sc Computer Science/B.Sc Information Technology with atleast 55% marks or equivalent CGPA from a recognized University/Institute.

Relaxation as per rules will be applicable in the case of SC/ST/OBC and other Eligible candidates.

b) Intake of the programme :-

20 seats (15 seats + 5 supernumerary seats reserved for Police Personnel in Service, Sponsored by Kerala Police Academy).

c) Duration of the course :-

2 years in semester pattern. There will be four semesters in the entire course, with two semester per year.

d) Fee Structure :-

Tuition Fee	- ₹15,315/- per semester
Laboratory Fee	- ₹1,500/- per semester
Library Fee	- ₹330/- per semester
Quasi Fee	- ₹100/- per semester

e) Additional fees, if any, as per University Regulations.

The Syndicate resolved, vide paper read as (3) above, to ratify the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor.
